You don't have to collect these in order, but you do have to collect them all! Use one of your teammates cell phones to take the pictures, then write the answers to the questions below. This can be done with families, youth groups, or Sunday Schools of all ages (as long as one person per team can read and write!)

1. Picture: Selfie with a Verger

Question: What does a Verger do? A verger is a person within the Church who assists the clergy in the conduct of public worship (or however the Verger described her/his job.)

2. Picture: The 4th Station of the Cross

Question: What does this depict? Jesus meets his mother, Mary

3. Picture: Someone in a Robe (besides the Verger)

Question: What kind of robe is it? This will differ

4. Picture: The Ambry (pronounced Ombre.)

Question: What is inside the Ambry? Wine and wafers

Bonus Question: How can you tell if it is full? The candle is lit.

5. Picture: Today's Gospel Reading

Question: Who reads the Gospel out loud during the service? The deacon or the priest.

6. Picture: The Sacristy Door

Question: What is in the sacristy? The sacristy is where the Altar Guild keeps the items for Eucharist such as the Chalice, the Wafers, the Cruets etc.

7. Picture: A Stole

Question: What do the colors of the stoles tell us? What time of year on the Liturgical Calendar it is

8. Picture: A stained glass window

Question: What scripture or bible story does this window depict? Will differ per church

9. Picture: Book of Common Prayer

Question: What is a sacrament as stated in the Catechism? An outward and visible sign of inward and spirtial grace, given by Christ as sure and certain means by which we receive that grace. OR any of the sacraments could be listed.

10. Picture: Baptismal Font

Question: Who Baptized Jesus? His cousin John the Baptist or John the Baptizer
